next steps that will help new people to connect further with our church family. The whole lunch is done in under one hour.



But it can be adapted to be used with the leaders and small groups of people who wish to be discipled in this way. MOTR contains some introductory material on mentorship itself and its importance. It is then divided into 20 conversations about the interior life of the pastor and 20 conversations about the exterior ministry of the pastor.
